- On Safety, during "O" Flights, no cadets are to be near the aircraft when it is being serviced. The CVH police are out in force, adhere to speed limits and speed bumps. There are new forms on the web site for safety, use the current forms.

- CAP form 7's – you are all doing great on these. Remember to sign them.
- Fuel slips must have the price per gallon on the slip.
