Mishap Reporting and Investigation

CAPR 62-2, 19 December 2012, is supplemented as follows:

Attachment 7, NER Notification Procedures and Roster is amended to include:

(ADDED) 1(a) CTWG Supplement 1 to CAPR 62-2 requires that all units maintain a mishap notification roster when reporting a mishap and notify specific Wing Members.

(ADDED) 2(a) Personnel assigned to Connecticut Wing Headquarters or appointed as a Project Officer for a Wing- sponsored activity are responsible for the safety of all personnel and property at that activity. In the event of a mishap that causes injury or damage to resources, the senior-ranking member and / or Activity/Project Officer that is present and able to communicate is required to have a form 78 electronically filed (leave investigator box blank) and to immediately notify the CT Wing Commander, or in his/her absence, the Wing Vice Commander; and the Wing Director of Safety. In the event they cannot be reached, the Wing Chief of Staff should be notified of the mishap.

(ADDED) Para 3 (a) as follows: Connecticut Wing
